Clean-up of Anacostia River sediments is the focus of the ARSP that was started by DOEE in October 2013 and continues in conjunction with the National Park Service. In March 2016, DOEE released the Draft Phase 1 Remedial Investigation (RI) Report that identified the extent and location of contamination throughout the river. During the summer of 2016, DOEE conducted the Phase 2 RI Sampling Program to address data gaps identified during the public comment for the Phase 1 RI Report. The project is currently on track with the Record of Decision that describes the clean-up remedy for the river planned for June 30, 2018.
