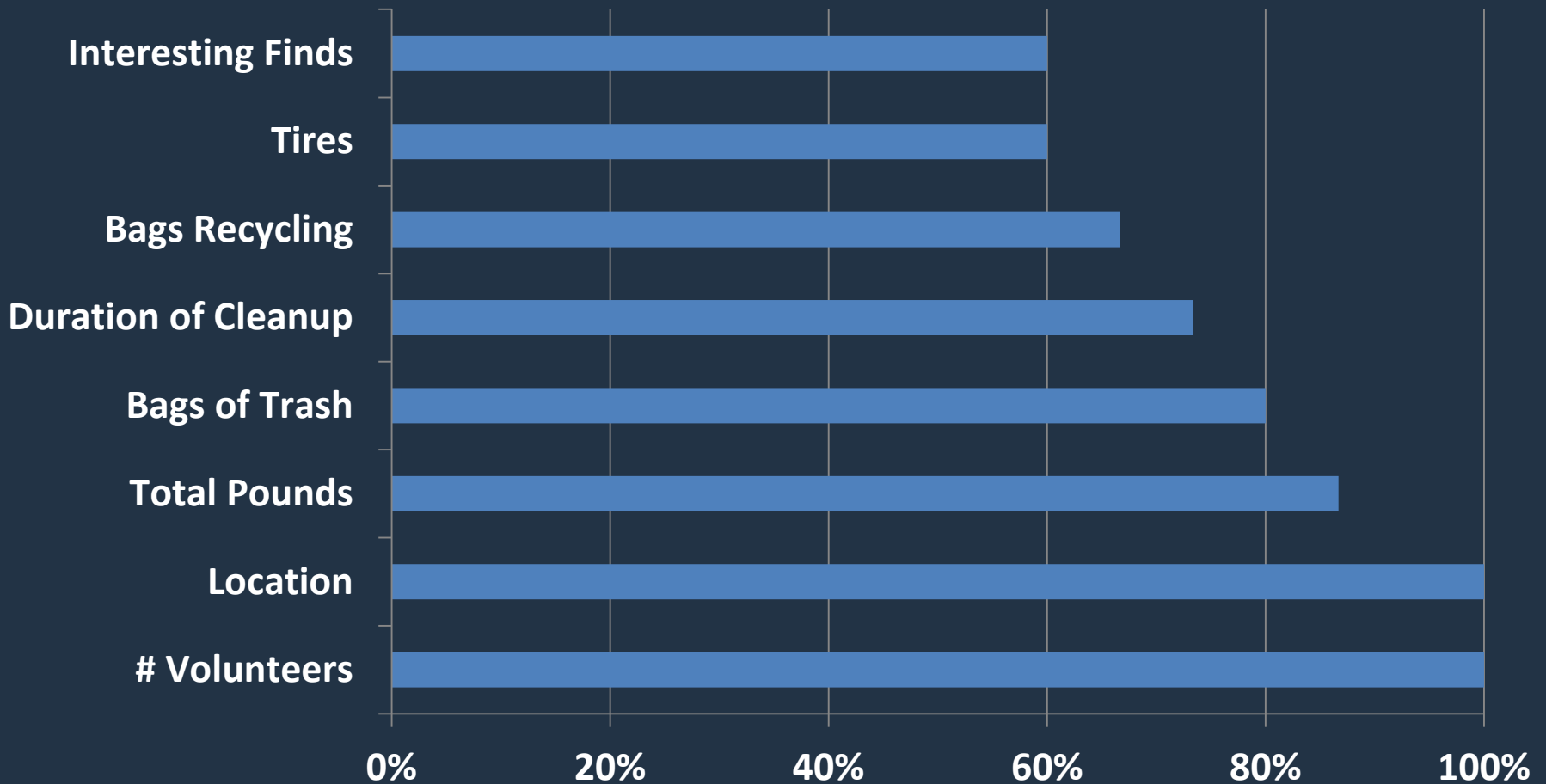

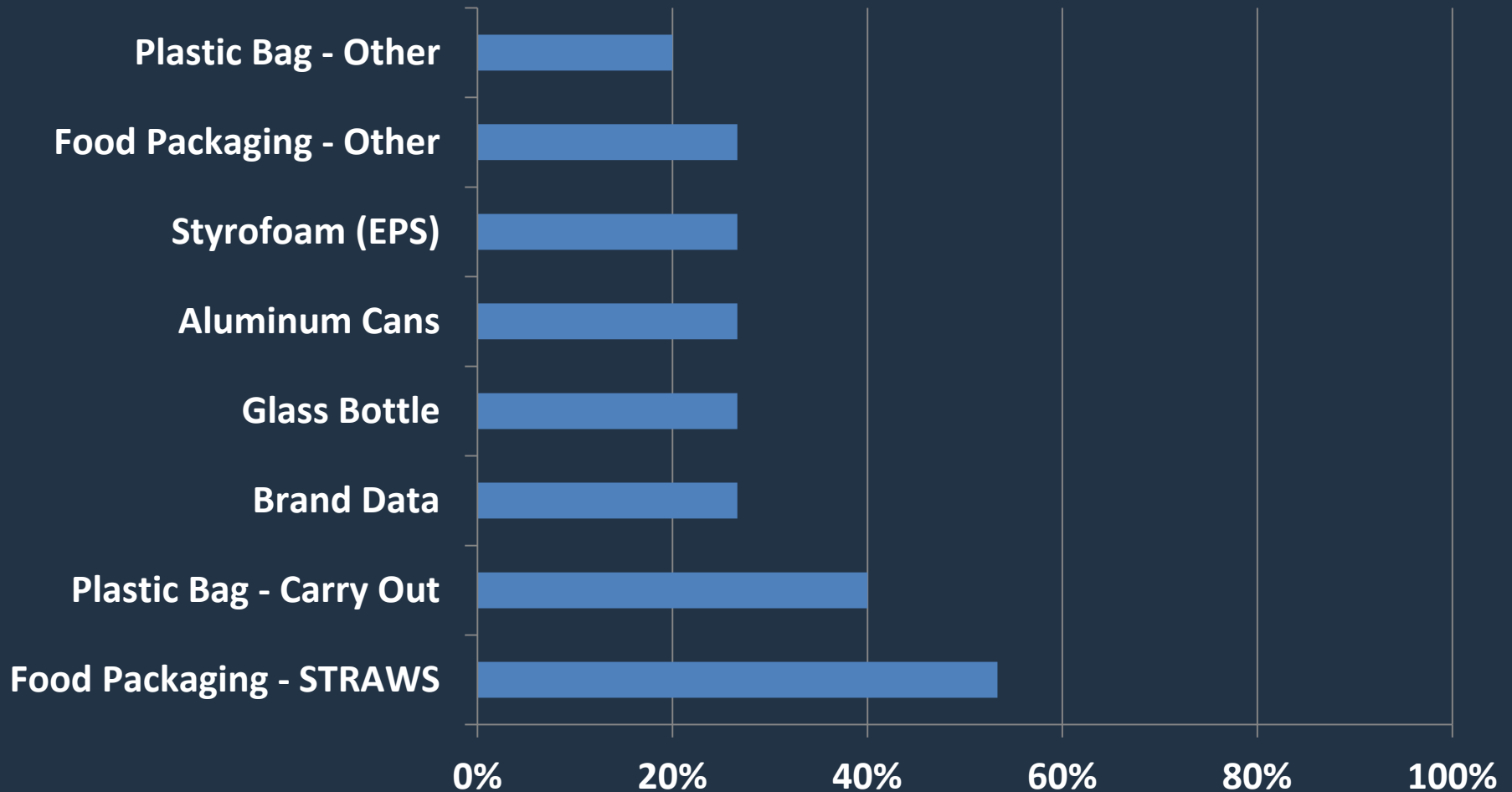

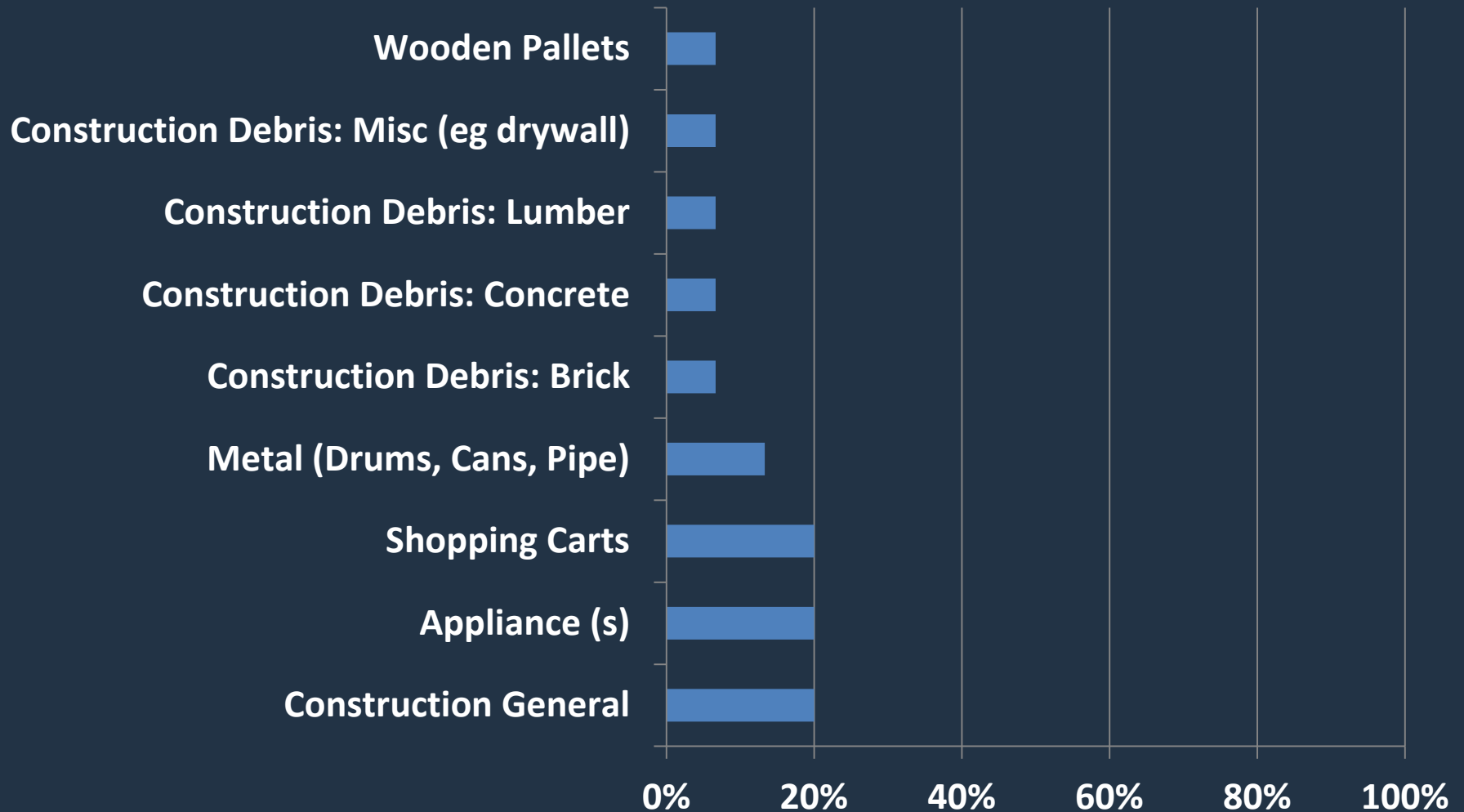
What data are we collecting?

How are we collecting data?

- Paper Data Sheets (Potomac Cleanup, International Coastal Cleanup etc.)
- Online Database (Trash Network, Project Clean Stream etc.)
- Smart Phone App (PGC LitterTrak, Clean Swell, Marine Debris Tracker etc.)
- Excel Files

Key Takeaways

- People (non-profits, volunteers) are interested in **cleanup data sharing & standardization**
- The most consistent reported data is number of volunteers and number of bags of trash
- Volunteers are not interested in a lengthy data process, we need to prioritize the trash data that we want to monitor
- Strong interest in **streamlined data collection** across the region

Ideal Next Steps

- Agree on a standardized set of data to collect throughout the region
- Agree to share regional data through a searchable, publicly accessible database
- Agree on a unified, streamlined data collection system

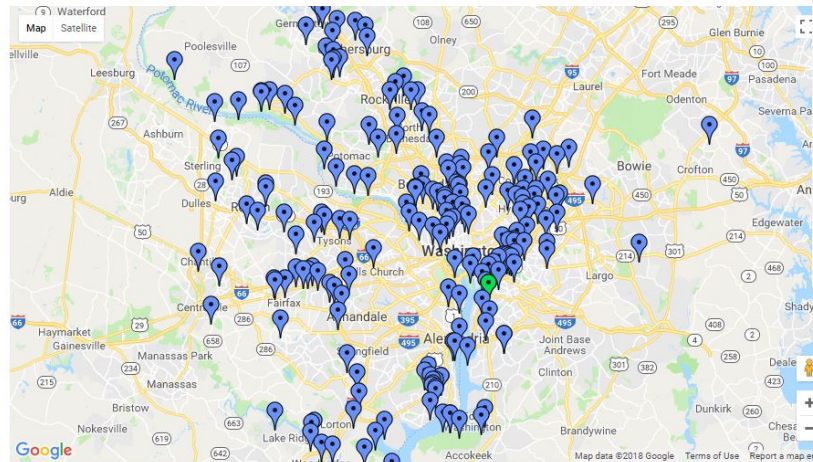
Trash Network 2.0

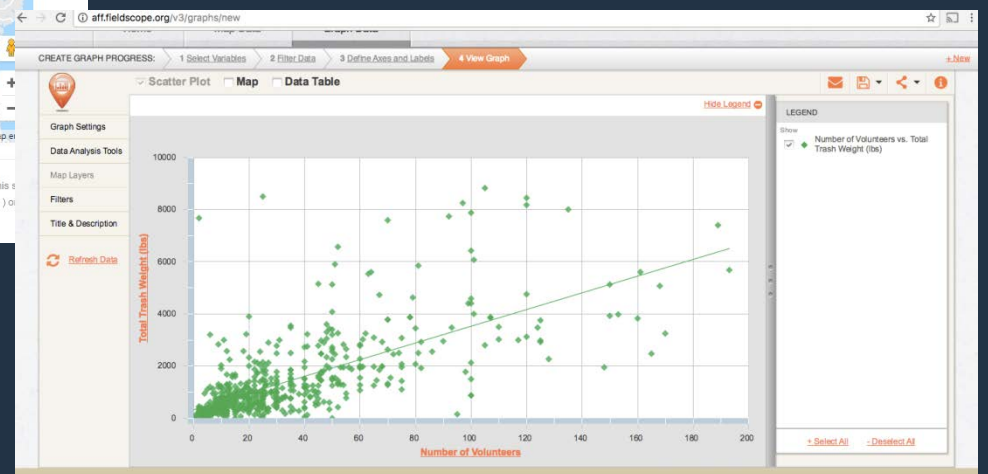
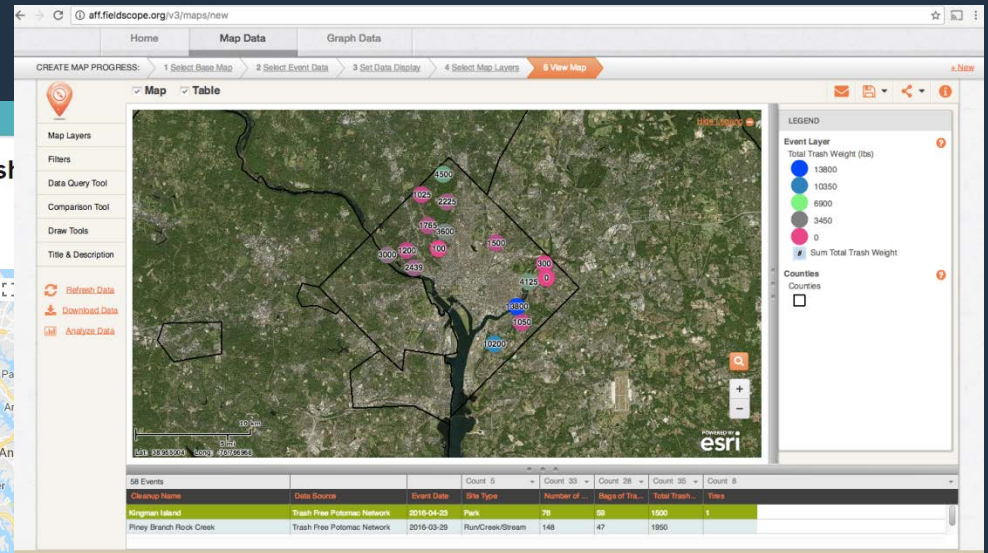
Trash Free Potomac Network - Connecting for a Trash Free Watershed
